

**RESOLUTION NO. 2013-3**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Towamensing has an Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION, CONVEYANCE AND REMOVAL BY THE TOWNSHIP OF TOWAMENSING OF GARBAGE, RUBBISH AND ASHES: DEFINING MEANING OF TERMS AS USED IN THIS ORDINANCE: IMPOSING CERTAIN DUTIES UPON HOUSEHOLDERS AND OTHERS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF," being Ordinance No. 80-2 of the Township of Towamensing; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 6 of said Ordinance provides that "the fees for the collection and disposal of refuse placed for collection at the side of the street or alley from which collection is made shall be determined by Resolution of the Township Supervisors"; and

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution No. 2013-1, the Board of Supervisors established the rates, including discounts and penalties to be charged for the garbage collection services provided by the Township in 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the Supervisors of Towamensing Township, by this Resolution, desire to amend Resolution No. 2013-1 to establish a discount for disabled veterans effective May 2, 2013.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby resolved that if one or more of the heads of the household of the family residing in the home for which the garbage collection service is provided, is a disabled veteran for any portion of the calendar year, the fee set forth in Section C above shall be reduced from \$190.00 to \$105.00. All other provisions of Section C shall apply to this discount. In order to qualify for this discount:

1. The veteran must have been honorably discharged or released under honorable conditions from the armed forces of the United States for service in a war or armed conflict in which




the United States was engaged; and,

2. As a result of the military service, the veteran is blind or paraplegic or has sustained the loss of two (2) or more limbs, or has a service-connected disability declared by the United States Department of Veterans' Affairs or its successors to be a total or 100% permanent disability; and

3. Each year the Applicant desires to receive the discount, the Applicant must provide the Township Secretary with documentation from the United States Department of Veterans' Affairs evidencing 1 and 2 above.
