Lakeview Estates – Site Inspection: Township Engineer Greg Haas completed a site inspection of the subdivision on March 13, 2015. He stated that there remained some minor cleanup and stabilization. **Motion:** Supervisor Guy Seifert made a Motion to release the letter of credit and lower security to an escrow account of \$17,000.00, seconded by Chairperson Penny Kleintop. Woods Campground – Final Plan:

Patrick Gremling, an owner of the Woods Campground, was in attendance. The Final/Partially As-Built Plan was reviewed by Township Engineer Greg Haas and his Land Development Review Comments dated April 1, 2015 were issued. Comments were as follows:

1. Financial security and an Improvements Agreement must be provided. [Sec. 406., Sec. 613.01., and Sec. 705] A 'Remaining Improvements Estimate' prepared by Keystone Consulting Engineers, Inc.

- dated April 1, 2015 had been provided and is acceptable. The amount of financial security required for the remaining site work is \$299,655.79.
- 2. The aquifer evaluation shall be completed and all results provided to the Township. The proposed water supply system must be approved by the PA DEP. Copies of all approval letters shall be provided. [Sec. 502.03.a., Sec. 504.03.a.3.b. and Sec. 607.01.]
- 3. Adequate assurances of maintenance, indemnification, and security shall be provided for the proposed drainage and stormwater management facilities. A maintenance and operating agreement shall be provided. [Sec. 703.03.f., Sec. 804.01.a., and Sec. 807.]

Motion: Supervisor Seifert made a Motion to give conditional final approval, based on the above-listed conditions being completed within 120 days, or an extension request in writing being made within that time period. The motion was seconded by Chairperson Penny Kleintop. All in favor. Motion carried.
