PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

ROLL CALL

Penny Kleintop, Chairperson/Treasurer; Tom Newman, Vice-Chairman; Guy Seifert, Supervisor; and Lora Nothstein, Secretary.

Discussion of County use of Township property for ramp to store county mixed paper product.

Chairperson Penny Kleintop explained that the county has been using the township property to store paper product from all Carbon County recycling areas. A ramp has been built to accommodate the paper drops at the expense of the township. This ramp is only used by the county. She is in favor of giving the county 10 to 20 days time before closing the ramp.

Vice-Chairman Tom Newman said the deal that was made was between a previous supervisor and Duane Dellecker. The profit from the recycling would be 90% to the county and 10% to the township. If the township received \$500.00 per month it would take 20 months for the township to recover the cost of the ramp. At this time the county has not been willing to pay for one half the cost of building the ramp.

Supervisor Guy Seifert expressed his concern that the county has not acted in good faith. And suggested that the ramp be dismantled and the trailer removed.

Vice-chairman Tom Newman made motion that the county be notified that as of Monday June 4, 2012 at 4pm the ramp will be inaccessible and the container removed.

Motion seconded by Supervisor Guy Seifert.
