

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-1

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TOWAMENSING,
COUNTY OF CARBON, COMMONWEALTH OF
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 94-1
ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
TOWAMENSING REGULATING THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES
AND BUILDINGS IN THE TOWNSHIP, AND PRESCRIBING
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION."**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Towamensing Township, Carbon County, Pennsylvania, that Ordinance No. 94-1 entitled "An Ordinance of the Township of Towamensing Regulating the Numbering of Houses and Buildings in the Township, and Prescribing Penalties for Violation." (hereinafter "Ordinance No. 94-1") be amended as follows:

1. The first paragraph of Section 3(a) (Requirements for Numbers) shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:
 - (a) The numbers shall be placed in a position to be clearly visible from the street or road fronting the property and be equally visible in either direction of travel. The numbers shall be a minimum of four (4") inches (100 mm) high with a minimum stroke width of one-half (1/2") inch (13 mm), shall be made of highly reflective vinyl or similar reflective material, and shall contrast with their immediate background. The numbers shall be Arabic numerals or alphabet letters.
2. In the second paragraph of Section 3(a) (Requirements for Numbers) the phrase "and the numbers shall be at least three (3) inches in height" shall be deleted.
3. The following sentence shall be added to the end of Section 3(a) (Requirements for Numbers):

In the cases of houses and buildings sharing a driveway, multi-unit houses or buildings, or where the building numbers are placed on a post, mailbox post, or similar structure located on the opposite side of the street from the house or building the number refers to, a directional arrow shall accompany the numbers in such a manner as to clearly designate the house or building the numbers refer to.
4. In the third last line of Section 4 (Numbering System) the number "2,363" is deleted and replaced by the number "3,263".
5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
6. Ordinance No. 94-1 is amended in no other way.
7. This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after it is enacted.


