RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TOWAMENSING TOWNSHIP, CARBON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING FEES PURSUANT TO THE PENNSYLVANIA SEWAGE FACTILITIES ACT.

WHEREAS, Towamensing Township is a township of the Second Class located in Carbon County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act provides that Towamensing

Township may set and collect fees for the activities set forth below:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Towamensing Township that the following fees are established for the year 2015:

## SEWAGE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER FEE SCHEDULE FOR TOWAMENSING TOWNSHIP

#### 1. Soil Testing Fees

Evaluate soil probes, maximum three per lot	\$250.00
Additional soil probes beyond three per lot	\$ 30.00 each probe
Perform six hole perc test	\$450.00
Perform additional perc holes, per hole	\$ 50.00
Observe perc tests, maximum four simultaneous tests	\$200.00

# 2. Permit and Inspection Fees

Application, review, issue, complete system	\$200.00
Application, review, issue, new tank or tank repair	\$ 50.00
Two inspections, mound or subsurface systems	\$300.00
One inspection, in-ground systems	\$150.00
One inspection, new tank or tank repair	\$150.00
Each additional inspection required, per inspection	\$150.00
Re-issue expired permit	\$100.00
Well distance exemption review letter	\$100.00

### 3. Other Fees

Verify prior soil testing

\$150.00 per test

All other duties, including meetings at Township request, planning module reviews, site consultations, year-end report preparation\*, complaint investigations and enforcement\*

\$ 80.00 per hour

\*Township pays fees for the year-end report preparation and complaint investigations and enforcement.

- 1. The Sewage Enforcement Officer is authorized to perform soil testing for sewage planning modules and to sign the false swearing statement on the module.
- 2. The Sewage Enforcement Officer is authorized to collect all fees and remit them to the Township with the SEO activity report on a monthly or bimonthly basis.
- 3. The Township will remit all fees back to the Sewage Enforcement Officer as payment for services rendered.
