**A RESOLUTION OF TOWAMENSING TOWNSHIP,
CARBON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE
SUPERVISORS OF TOWAMENSING TOWNSHIP TO
ENFORCE SECTION 2326 OF THE SECOND CLASS
TOWNSHIP CODE, 53 P.S. § 67326.**

WHEREAS, Towamensing Township is a township of the second class located in Carbon County, Pennsylvania; and,

WHEREAS, section 2326 of The Second Class Township Code provides:

Any person who obstructs any public road or commits any nuisance thereon by felling trees, making fences, turning the road, diverting water onto or in any other way or who does not, on notice given by the board of supervisors, immediately remove the obstruction or nuisance and repair the damages done to the road commits a summary offense. Nothing in this section shall debar a prosecution for any nuisance as in case of misdemeanor at common law.

WHEREAS, by this Resolution, the Board of Supervisors of Towamensing Township desire to recognize the authority of the Supervisors of Towamensing Township to enforce section 2326 of The Second Class Township Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED as follows:

RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors of Towamensing Township hereby recognizes the authority of the Supervisors of Towamensing Township to enforce section 2326 of the Second Class Township Code.

RESOLVED FURTHER, this authority is given to not only the current Supervisors of Towamensing Township (Guy Seifert, Scott Mosier, and John Kleintop), but also to those persons who may hold that position in the future.
